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Rural Land Register Mapping Update – 2009

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

You will shortly be receiving a new set of digital maps from the Rural Payments Agency, these maps will provide the basis for the 2010 Single Payment Scheme Forms.

Why are the RPA producing new maps?

The RPA have been using mapping data from 2001 and they are converting to a new mapping system that updates itself regularly and accounts for real world changes.

The RPA now want to identify all ineligible field features such as ponds and produce maps showing the total land parcel sizes and claimable field areas. This new information will be pre printed on the 2010 Single Payment Scheme SP5 form and will be the base for future payments.

What do you need to do?

The RPA are allowing only **28 days** from receipt for you to check the maps, make amendments on a Reply Form (RMU1) and return it to the RPA.

It is important that all eligible land is correctly mapped and any ineligible features are correctly accounted for.

From past experiences you will appreciate that the maps are likely to be incorrect and will need amending - **we cannot stress enough the need for these to be correct** - failure to accurately correct the maps could lead to reductions in the claimable area of your holding and therefore reductions in payment.

Mapping Update Service
